






Utility Relocation: Ongoing through summer




Longer Lane Reductions



Decking: Fourth Quarter 2019



Deployment Process:

- Project team observations and community feedback
- Collect traffic counts
- Verify compliance with Municipal Code thresholds
- Deploy strategic tools
- Increase enforcement
- Continue monitoring


